Dear Parent,

We are pleased with your interest in Community Christian School and welcome the application for your child to attend CCS. We look forward to the opportunity of working with you in the Christian education of our child (ren) through a curriculum, which teaches God's central place in all of life. In support of the central focus of Community Christian School, the following criteria must be met for admission to Community Christian School.

I. Criteria established for admission to the Community Christian School

A. Parents are expected to:

1. Agree with and sign the Statement of Beliefs and Objectives found with the application form
2. Regularly attend and participate in the life of a Christian church

B. Students are expected to:

1. Give evidence of potential academic success in the school's program based on previous records and recommendations
2. Give evidence of good social adjustment, satisfactory behavior, and emotional ability

II. Steps of Completing the Application and Admission Process

- A. Return the Application Form
- B. Return Statement of Beliefs & Objectives (Included in Application)
- C. Return Family Agreement Form (Included in Application)
- D. Return Parent Commitment Form (Included in Application)
- E. Return the Pastor/Priest Reference form or have them send the form in the mail to CCS

III. Interview with Families

Following completion of the application, the Principal and two Board members will interview the family of each student. During the interview, parents will be asked the following:

- A. To talk about their Christian commitment through their relationship with Jesus Christ
- B. Explain your desire to send your child to Community Christian School
- C. To clarify and ask questions regarding the student's application – academic, social, behavioral, spiritual and physical needs.

CCS believes strongly that the education of a child involves three vital components - the home, the school and the church. Our goal is to know that we will be working together, guiding your child in a consistent direction through the home and church as well as through our efforts at Community Christian School.
