



Dear Parents/Guardian,

We are pleased with your interest in Community Christian School and welcome the application for your child to attend CCS. We look forward to the opportunity of working with you in the Christian education of our child (ren) through a curriculum, which teaches God's central place in all of life. In support of the central focus of Community Christian School, the following criteria must be met for admission to Community Christian School.

Parents are expected to:

- Agree with and sign the Educational Philosophy, CCS Statement of Beliefs & Objectives, & Statement on Marriage, Gender & Sexuality
- One parent is regularly attending and is an active member in the life of a Christian Bible-believing church.
- Parent(s) show evidence of their positive relationship with Jesus Christ
- CCS requires at least one parent to be a professing Christian

Students are expected to:

- Give evidence of potential academic success in the school's program based on previous records and recommendations
- Give evidence of good social adjustment, satisfactory behavior, and emotional stability

Step 1: PARENTS AND/OR GUARDIANS MUST PROVIDE:

- Completed CCS Application Form
- Completed Parent Questionnaire in application
- \$75 Non-Refundable Registration Fee
- Transcripts from previous school (if, applicable)
- Copy of Immunization records
- CCS Health Form (included with paperwork)
- Custodial Document Information (if applicable)

Application: Students must be the appropriate age for the grade in which they are making application. For Kindergarten students, the child must be age 5 by September 1 in order to start the school year.

Transcripts: Copies of the student's official transcripts and most recent achievement test results. Transcripts must reflect at least 75% average in core classes where a grading scale was used, and no failing grades in any classes.

Immunization Records: Required to be submitted prior to admissions testing.

Health Form: A health form allows us to make any allowances for children that have any particular health concerns that CCS should be made aware prior to the upcoming school year.

Step 2: ADMISSION ASSESSMENT

CCS will call to set up a time to have prospective student assessed in reading and math

- Kindergarten: Complete a Kindergarten assessment at CCS
- Grades 1 - 8: Complete a Math and Reading assessment at CCS

Step 3: INTERVIEW WITH FAMILIES

Following completion of the application and student assessment, the family will be interviewed by CCS. ONLY students applying to enter grades 5 - 8 are expected to be present and participate in the interview. Children that are younger than 5th grade should not participate in the Family Interview. After consideration of the application materials and interview, the committee will decide whether the family and child meet the criteria for admission to CCS.

CCS believes strongly that the education of a child involves three vital components - the home, the school and the church. Our goal is to know that we will be working together, guiding your child in a consistent direction through the home and church as well as through our efforts at Community Christian School.
